Project went to tender last week. Contractor to be appointed on 2nd August. The Building prep starts 15th August and building starts 30th August. Discussed possible hall expansion using the MOE SIP fund. The money could also be used to upgrade the pool changing rooms. The Board agreed to proceed with the hall renovations. SM/IC: Carried. All in favour. Conclusion and Action: The Principal's Report was tabled, received and taken as read. JH to progress hall renovations.
2.2 NAG – Reporting to Parents	Conclusion: The NAG – Reporting to Parents was tabled, received and taken as read.
2.3 Māori Achievement Plan	DF presented the Māori Achievement Plan.

	 The plan to normalise te reo over the school with various activities in the class is in progress. The most obvious difference from last year is that there are more children needing support for a variety of learning issues. Whaea Mere is a great help in this area. Conclusion: The Māori Achievement Plan was tabled, received and taken as read. 	
2.4 Pasifika Achievement Plan	 MP presented the Pasifika Achievement Plan. Maths and literacy classes held at lunchtime are popular. Pasadena and Westmere Pasifika children have recently begun working together at each school. Conclusion: The Pasifika Achievement Plan was tabled, received, taken as read. 	
2.5 Student Led Conference - Review	 CA presented the Student Led Conference Review. Parents enjoyed student led conferences format. 96% attendance. A positive result. The students enjoyed presenting via Hero and teachers enjoyed using Hero too. 13% of parents would like more time with the teachers. Teachers recommended that the 20 minute timeframe stays the same due to time constraints on the day. Parents are always welcome to make an appointment to speak further with teachers. Conclusion: The Student Led Conference Review was tabled, received, and taken as read. 	
2.6 Future Focus - Review	 KW presented the Future Focus review. Digital curriculum continues to be worked on and implemented. A sustainability focus is new this year. Recruitment of new tech teacher in progress. Conclusion: The Future Focus Review was tabled, received, and taken as read.	
2.7 Report on Māori Consultation Hui	 DF presented the Māori Consultation Hui Report. The Hui took place in March and was well attended. A positive experience, with many people keen to help. Year 7s totally ready for immersion classes this year. Researching opportunities for kapa haka group to perform. Trip to Auckland art gallery to view Toi Tū Toi Ora took place as suggested at the Hui and was well received. Conclusion: The Report on Māori Consultation Hui was tabled, received, and taken as read.

2.9 Finance Report	 Full set of reports prepared via Xero, which were very comprehensive and informative. Fundraiser format was very successful.
