Nagisa Hiroshima Junior High School Exchange 2020



Since 1995 Pasadena Intermediate and Nagisa Hiroshima Junior High School have been involved in annual student exchanges. To date, a total of over 425 Pasadena students have participated in the exchange programme.

In 2020 there will again be student exchanges. The first will be in May (18/5/20 - 30/5/20) when twenty students will fly to Hiroshima, via Tokyo, and will attend Nagisa Hiroshima Senior and Junior High School (a private school).

Students on this exchange will stay in a hotel during the stopover in Tokyo and will be hosted by a Japanese student's family in Hiroshima, having the opportunity to genuinely experience Japanese culture and hospitality.

During this stay they will attend their host student's class, and participate in

- Physical Education, Music, Science, Art, Mathematics, English
- Attend Japanese classes such as Flower Arranging
- Excursions to places of interest in the region of Hiroshima

The students will be accompanied by two Pasadena staff members. The cost including all fares, accommodation, food allowance in Tokyo, transfers and comprehensive travel insurance will be between \$3,400 - \$3,600.

Later in July (22/7/20 - 1/8/20), Pasadena will host students from Nagisa Hiroshima Senior and Junior High School where they will experience a similar exchange here, staying with our students who participate in May.

Past exchanges have proved to be fantastic learning experiences for the students who have participated, with many making lifelong friends.
